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**INTRODUCTION**

The following report is issued pursuant to Article 5 of the Transparency and Expedited Procedure for Access to Public Information Act of 2020 (Law Num. 141 of August 1, 2020) and Circular Letter 2020-01 of the Puerto Rico Department of Justice. Information Officers are required to submit to the head of the government entity a monthly report containing the following information: (1) the number of requests received; (2) the type of public information requested; and (3) the status of the Request for Public Information. Applicable law and regulation also require that said reports will be public and available on the agency's website.
